How is your solution innovative? 120 words

What are 2-3 points of difference that make your idea different or better to any other existing solutions. Who are your closest (1-3) competitors? NOTE: We will Google your idea to see you've a) identified competitors and b) that your idea is truly unique.

IMPLEMENTATION

Have you done anything to take your idea out of the classroom and into the real world? (optional) 120 words

Have you received feedback? What was it, and how did your idea change? Have you tested your solution with real users / customers and what did they say? Have you secured funding, manufacturing and/or other key partnerships or support? Do you already have paying customers?

What are the next three things you need to do next to launch or scale your idea? 120 words

Think of a roadmap. If you won the National Finals, what would you use the prize money & support packages for? In this question, we're trying to see how 'ready' and prepared you are to take the next step with your idea.

Video: Why you, & why now?

In this section, we want to hear why the problem that you're solving matters to you.

Create & upload a one (1) minute video telling us: Why should we pick you?

We're not looking for polish, we're looking for passionate young people with ideas that have potential.

Why you? Why now? What makes you (or your idea) different?

DO NOT GO OVER TIME as the judges will only watch the first minute.

Filming on your laptop or phone is fine. The judges are looking for CONTENT NOT POLISH, so focus on answering the question within the time limit, rather than fancy presentation.

If you are providing a link to an external site, please ensure sharing permissions are set so that external contacts can view your video. You may also want to consider video converters like Handbrake or Any Video Converter Free to reduce the file size.
